-Supervisor DiGiacomo calls for any public comment before the Town Board goes into Executive session.

On a Motion made by Councilman Bardascini and Seconded by Councilman Rorick to Enter Executive Session for personnel interviews at 6:32pm.

Discussion; Councilwoman Ryan questions how the new Historian will become oriented. Then suggests that she get in touch with The Historical Society.

-The Town Board members had a discussion with Code Enforcer Stephen Quinlan pertaining to the Assistant Code Enforcer position.

-Councilman Bardascini states that with the code compliance there is still 2 feet of snow on the ground there is sometime before the process starts. Councilman Bardascini states they he and Councilman Bogardus are going to get together to update the building permit the following week then he feels as though The Town needs to get together to fix the Junk Law.

-The Board has agreed to work on updating The Town Laws prior to enactment.

-Councilman Rorick states that The Town may have to hire an Assessor without training for longevity purposes.

-Councilman Bardascini states that he spoke to Ian from Fulton County pertaining to The Veterans Law. Councilman Bardascini stated that Ian said 99% of veterans would not qualify with how it is currently written.

-Councilwoman Ryan suggests The Town does not move forward as they were advised not to.

Councilman Bardascini states that when The Town is updated with the final version that they can move forward at that point.

-Supervisor DiGiacomo states that they will continue to conduct interviews at next month's meeting.
